Prose submissions must be under twenty-five pages, double-spaced, and addressed to the Prose Editor. Please send no more than five poems, and address them to the Poetry Editor. Art submissions should consist of up to six pieces submitted either as slides or on a CD as .jpg or .tiff files, and should be addressed to the Art Editor.

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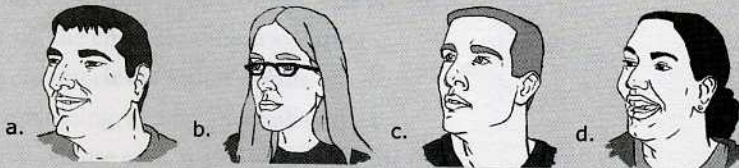
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# IQ Questions

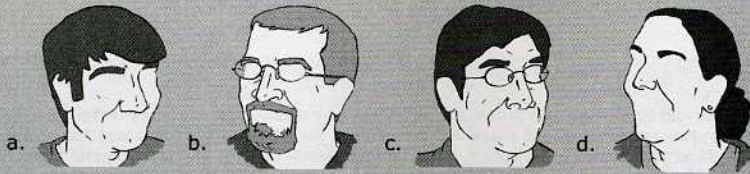
